

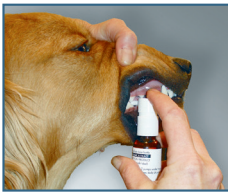

### Allergenspecific what?

**Start adressing the underlying disease and not only treating the symptoms!**

**10-15% of dogs suffer from atopic dermatitis.**

**Only 5% of them get offered allergen-specific immunotherapy.**

Peter Forsythe will share with you his clinical experience with allergen-specific immunotherapy (ASIT) – the only treatment which will modify the underlying disease. Get more familiar with the different immunotherapies: aqueous or alum precipitated and sublingual options. How to combine ASIT with other medications? When and how to adjust the protocol?

Peter graduated from the Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies in 1983.

He spent fourteen years in mixed general practice including a year working in Australia. He developed an interest in dermatology in the late '80's and gained the RCVS Certificate in Small Animal Dermatology in 1992. In 1997 he returned to the Dick Vet to do a residency in dermatology and gained the RCVS Diploma in 2001. Since then he has run a referral dermatology practice based in Glasgow and

Aberdeen in Scotland. The practice now employs two specialist dermatologists and a resident. He is an RCVS recognised specialist in dermatology and an honorary lecturer in dermatology at Glasgow Veterinary School.
